RE: Zero Waste Audit Results

Dear Mr. Cerny,

At the request of Connor Sport Court International (CSCI), SWCA Environmental Performance Group (EPG) has performed an independent, third party audit of CSCI's solid waste disposal practices and has calculated your landfill diversion rate. This letter summarizes the results of our audit.

Scope of the Audit

The scope of this audit included a review of the following information, provided by CSCI, for both the Salt Lake City, Utah and Amasa, Michigan facilities:

- Landfill waste, annual tonnage
- Recycled waste, annual tonnage
- Reused waste, annual tonnage
- Recycling policies and practices

From this information review, EPG calculated the landfill diversion rate for each facility and for the company as a whole. In addition, EPG interviewed relevant CSCI staff regarding recycling practices at each facility as well as employee awareness of, and engagement in, CSCI's landfill waste diversion practices.

Definitions of Terminology

Because solid waste auditing is a relatively new practice, EPG has provided the following definitions, consistent with current practices and meanings found in the marketplace.

Landfill Diversion Rate: A means of expressing the amount of potential landfill waste not sent to area landfills, as a percentage of total solid waste. Waste not sent to area landfills can include: recycled waste, waste reused internally, waste sold to a third party as a process input, and waste consumed in waste-to-energy facilities.

Zero Waste: “Zero Waste” is an ongoing goal. However, any facility, company, or other organization with a landfill diversion rate of 90% or higher can be termed as “Zero Waste,” as per the Zero Waste Business Principals of the Zero Waste International Alliance.

Findings and Conclusions

Based on our review of CSCI’s facility-level solid waste data and interviews with key CSCI personnel, EPG has calculated CSCI’s overall landfill diversion rate to be 99%, meaning only 1% of CSCI’s waste is disposed of in a landfill. As a result, CSCI’s overall landfill diversion rate of 99% meets and even well exceeds the Zero Waste requirement, as defined in this document.

EPG is pleased to provide the following independent, third party opinion regarding CSCI’s solid waste practices:

Connor Sport Court International’s solid waste practices were audited by SWCA Environmental Performance Group in May 2009. The audit results indicate that CSCI has achieved a 99% landfill diversion rate that exceeds generally recognized criteria for designation as a Zero Waste company.

EPG congratulates CSCI on its environmental commitment to industry-leading landfill waste reduction practices.
